



RESCISSION OF ORDER OF THE HEALTH OFFICER Nos. c19-7c and c19-6c

DATE OF RESCISSION: November 15, 2021

Effective immediately, [Health Officer Order No. c19-7c \(Home Quarantine and Home Isolation \(revised\) issued on October 29, 2020\)](#) and [Appendix A \(Home Quarantine Instructions issued on December 22, 2020\)](#) are rescinded in full in accordance with Section 8 of those Orders.

While case rates are declining and more people are receiving COVID-19 vaccines, transmission rates of COVID-19 remain high and the risk of COVID-19 variants are still unknown. Accordingly, individuals should continue to follow guidance released by the United States Department of Health & Human Services ("HHS") including their sub-agency United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention ("CDC"), the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), California Department of Public Health ("CDPH"), and California Department of Social Services ("CDSS"). The Order is rescinded in order to align with the above-mentioned authorities and guidelines.
