- 1. <u>A Telephone report must be made immediately or as soon as practically possible</u> after receiving the information to the county where the incident occurred. The reporter shall provide the following information:
 - His/her name (this is not required if the person is a mandated reporter)
 - The name and age of the dependent adult or elder
 - The present location of the dependent adult or elder
 - The names and addresses of family members of any other person responsible for the dependent adult or elder's care
 - The nature and extent of the dependent adult or elder's condition
 - The date of the incident
 - Any other information requested by Adult Protective Services including information that led the reporter to suspect dependent adult or elder abuse.
- 2. <u>Mail or fax written report (Attachment F) to APS in county where incident</u> occurred within 2 working days
