

Prioritization Activity Methodology

Based on the Hanlon Method (see link: <u>https://www.naccho.org/uploads/downloadable-resources/Gudie-to-Prioritization-Techniques.pdf</u>)

CHIP Kick-Off participants were asked to assign a score of 1-3 to each health topic and criterion.








Total Summary Scores

During the prioritization activity, respondents scored each health topic area on a scale of 1 (least) to 3 (most) for two criteria: 1) Magnitude of Issue and 2) Ability to Impact. The summary score for each health topic area and criterion was calculated based on the average scores of 54 responses. The Total Summary Score for each health topic area is the average score of both criteria. The table below is sorted from highest to lowest based on the Total Summary Score for each health topic area.

Mental Health and Mental Disorders	2.81	2.48	2.65
Access to Health Care Services	2.67	2.46	2.56
Social Determinants of Health (Economy, Housing, Employment, Transportation)	2.89	2.04	2.46
Substance Use (Alcohol and Drug Use, Tobacco Use)	2.44	2.22	2.33
Diabetes	2.39	2.22	2.31
Nutrition and Healthy Eating, Physical Activity	2.15	2.24	2.19
Chronic Conditions (Heart Disease, Kidney Disease)	2.31	2.04	2.18
Respiratory Diseases (Asthma, Other Lung Issues)	1.94	1.85	1.90
Cancer	2.04	1.57	1.81



Magnitude of Issue (N=54) How concerning is this issue?








Ability to Impact (N=54)


How much ability do we have to impact this issue?
