To Whom It May Concern,

On October 22, 2024, the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors will consider an ordinance to approve an increase in existing fees in the Environmental Health Services Fee Schedule for the period of January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2025 and to adopt an automatic annual adjustment in fees, using the Consumer Price Index, annually thereafter.

Environmental Health Services (EHS) is the local government agency responsible for protecting public health and the environment. EHS does this by overseeing various business practices including food safety, housing program requirements, hazardous materials management, safe drinking water, and commercial swimming pool safety. This work is funded solely by fees. The proposed fee schedule and annual automatic adjustment are necessary to recover estimated reasonable costs of providing the associated services.
