#### Purpose of Today

- February 2013 Selection Committee approved MHA's proposal on Waverly Place
- Presentation of the Waverly Place proposal from Melissa Platt (MHA)
- Release for 30-day public comment



### Background

- Funding is to provide permanent supportive housing
  - Individuals who are eligible for MHSA services and meet eligible criteria as homeless or at-risk of being homeless
  - Operation and construction costs
  - Administered through CalHFA
- Counties to follow Statewide guidelines, for example:
  - Serve persons with serious mental illness who are homeless, or at risk of homelessness (as defined by MHSA Housing Program) and meet the MHSA HP target population
  - Definition of a qualified developers, application process, etc.
  - Limit on cost per unit \$126,531.60



#### MHSA Funded Projects in San Mateo

- Cedar Street Apartments 14 units
  - Approved in 2009, opened in May 2012
- El Camino Apartments 20 units
  - Approved in 2010, opened in September 2012
- Delaware Street Apartments 10 units
  - Approved in 2011, opened in November 2013

- Two Story Wood-Frame Construction
- 16 Total Units
- 15 Studio Apartments
- One 1-Bedroom Managers' unit
- Interior Courtyard
- Full Community Room with Kitchen
- Laundry room on each of two floors
- 15 parking spaces
