	Approval of April 2024 RAIC Minutes: Commissioner

	seconded. Commissioners Arnos, Barsi, and Giannini
	abstained since they had not been present in April. The
	minutes were approved.
	As discussed at the General Meeting, CoA's request for
	funding to pay the tabling fees for the Senior Showcase
	at the County Fair had been successful. Payment of the
	full fee entitles the Commission to place a small ad in
	the Daily Journal. Chair Lee circulated two samples of
	ads showing the size and possible text. It was decided
	to place an ad emphasizing the Commission on Aging,
	with a reference to the Help an Home guide. <b>Suki Ho</b>
	will work with Chair Lee on drafting the ad. It was
	decided to seek placement of the ad on the following
