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I. Executive Summary

Inmar Rx Solutions, Inc (“Inmar”) was conditionally approved to operate a Safe Drug Disposal Stewardship Program (“Program”) on October 21, 2022 in San Mateo County (“The County”) pursuant to the San Mateo County Safe Medicine Disposal Ordinance located in San Mateo County Ordinance Code Sections 4.116.010-4.116.191 (“Ordinance”). Inmar received conditional approval on October 21, 2022 for the Drug Stewardship Plan (“Plan”) plan dated September 9, 2022. This Annual Report is based on the Plan submitted on September 9, 2022 to The Division and is for the period between October 21, 2022 through December 31, 2022 (“Reporting Period”). All capitalized terminologies not defined in this summary are the same as those used in Inmar’s submitted Plan dated September 9, 2022, conditionally approved on October 21, 2022.

Throughout the Reporting Period, Inmar collected Unwanted Covered Drugs by means of Kiosk Drop-Off Sites. Due to the short nature of the reporting period, Mail-Back Distribution Sites were signed up to participate, but had not yet produced any returned envelopes. The table below represents the total weight collected in pounds by each of these mentioned Collection Methods.

B. Number of Mailers Provided for Disabled and/or Home-Bound Residents

Ordinance Sec. 4.116.090(a)(4) The number of mailers provided for disabled and/or home-bound County residents

A total of 580 Mailers were distributed via Mail-Back Distribution Sites as shown in the chart below. Disabled and/or home-bound County Residents have the opportunity to request Mailers via the program website and toll-free number as well as obtain a Mailer from eight Mail-Back Distribution Sites. Inmar is able to capture the total number of Mailers distributed to Mail-Back Distribution Sites and Mailers requested directly to County Residents, but is unable to ascertain whether or not the Resident is disabled and/or home-bound.

In accordance with DEA Regulations at 21 CFR 1317.70(d), Ultimate users and persons lawfully entitled to dispose of an ultimate user decedent's property shall not be required to provide any personally identifiable information when mailing back controlled substances to a collector. In an effort to protect Residents privacy and adhere to these regulations, Inmar does not ask Residents requesting Mailers to disclose if they are disabled and/or homebound. Requiring Residents to disclose disability and/or homebound status may also discourage participation in the Program. It is indicated on Inmar's educational materials that Mailers can be requested for the return of unwanted or expired medication.

The table below provides a breakdown of the type of Mailer and number of Mailers provided to Mail-back Sites and Ultimate Users and the number of returned Mailers by type. The number of Mailers provided does not always equate to the number of Mailers returned because mailers provided via any distribution method does not guarantee or ensure that Residents will return the Mailers for destruction.

Policies and Procedures for collecting, transporting and disposing of Unwanted Covered Drugs, as established in the Plan, were followed during the Reporting Period. Inmar was not notified of any Safety or Security Concerns for the Reporting Period.

VII. Educational Efforts and Public Outreach

Ordinance Sec. 4.116.090(a)(9): A description of the public education, outreach and evaluation activities implemented during the reporting period.

A. Public Education Effort and Promotion Strategy

In accordance with Section 4.116.060, Inmar provided clear, standardized disposal instructions for Kiosk Drop-Off Sites and Mail-Back Distribution Sites as outlined in the approved Plan. Inmar provided educational materials that promoted safe disposal options, the dangers of improper drug use and disposal, and other program information.

In the next Reporting Period, Inmar plans to host a Program website and toll-free number in conjunction with the other Program Operator to provide information on the Program, report Kiosk Drop-Off Sites problems, and to obtain Mailers. Once a neutrally branded website and toll-free number are created, Inmar plans to update all Program signage and educational materials to reflect this information. Additionally, Inmar plans to provide each Kiosk Drop-Off Site Educational materials to distribute in the required languages, as well as implement the media tactics as outlined in the Plan including social influencer marketing and targeted media.

B. Evaluation Activities

In accordance with Section 4.116.060(a)(4), the biennial survey will be conducted in 2024 with the existing Program Operator. The biennial survey will allow Inmar to effectively analyze the success of Inmar's educational outreach efforts and overall awareness of the Program.

VIII. Packaging and Recycling

Ordinance Sec. 4.116.090(a)(10): A description of how collected packaging was recycled to the extent feasible, including the recycling facility or facilities used.

As stated in the Plan submitted October 9, 2023, regulations prevent Inmar from recycling drug packaging due to regulation DEA § 317.75(c) prohibits handling substances after they have been deposited into a collection Kiosk. However, Inmar encourages Residents to separate Covered Drugs from drug packaging by placing Covered Drugs into a sealed bag via educational materials and to recycle the drug packaging.

IX. Program Goals

Ordinance 4.116.090(a)(11): A summary of the Stewardship Plan’s goals, the degree of success in meeting those goals in the past year, and, if any goals have not been met, what efforts will be made to achieve the goals in the next year.

Based on the Plan dated September 9, 2022, conditionally approved October 21, 2022, the table below lists the goals outlined in the Plan and the corresponding update. Due to the short nature of the Reporting Period, Inmar’s goals are still in progress and ongoing. Inmar is actively working on securing Kiosk Drop-Off Sites and Mail-Back Distribution Sites to supplement areas around the County that may be deemed underserved.

During the Reporting Period, Inmar provided Authorized Collectors with clear, standardized training materials. Inmar initiated the creation of educational materials to be distributed in the next Reporting Period, as well as initiated the search for social media influencers to be utilized for Social Influencer Marketing. Inmar utilized San Mateo County radio station KOIT 95.6 FM (“KOIT”) to provide information on safe drug disposal throughout the listening area. KOIT is consistently one of the top stations in San Mateo County and the Bay Area radio market. Messaging also ran simulcast across streaming platforms. The radio ads started the week of October 24, 2022 and ran through January 30th, 2023. Ads emphasized that safe drug disposal options are free to all Residents of San Mateo County. Inmar has insight into the scope of the program by identifying total impressions. During the radio campaign, Inmar was able to reach approximately 3,709,776 listeners. The advertisement ran 147 times.

The data from social media metrics will be utilized to develop a baseline percentage of Residents reached through these outreach tactics. Communications with the other Program Operator will begin immediately in the 2023 Reporting Period.
